1. General Information

These Terms and Conditions apply to all freediving activities, courses, training sessions, packages, and services

provided by Apnea Canarias Freediving Center (hereafter referred to as “the Center”). By booking and/or

participating in any activity, the client acknowledges having read, understood, and accepted these Terms and Conditions.

2. Booking and Payment

All bookings must be made in advance and are subject to availability. Full payment is required to confirm the

booking unless otherwise stated.

3. Client Requirements

- Be in good physical and mental health and fit for freediving activities
- Complete and sign a freediving medical questionnaire before the activity
- Provide a valid medical certificate if required by Spanish regulations
- Hold a valid freediving certification where required

The Center reserves the right to refuse participation to any client not meeting medical, safety, or training requirements.

4. Safety and Responsibility

All activities follow internationally recognized freediving safety standards. Clients must strictly follow instructors’

instructions. Failure to do so may result in immediate exclusion without refund.

5. Cancellation Policy

Client cancellation:

- More than 48 hours before the activity: rescheduling or refund possible
- Less than 48 hours before the activity or no-show: 100% of the amount charged (no refund)

Center cancellation:

In case of cancellation due to weather, sea conditions, safety concerns, or force majeure, the Center will offer

rescheduling or a refund.

6. Changes and Modifications

Schedules, locations, or programs may be modified for operational or safety reasons. Such changes do not entitle

clients to compensation.

7. Insurance

Clients must have adequate personal insurance covering freediving activities. The Center holds professional

liability insurance as required by Spanish law.

8. Liability

Freediving involves inherent risks. Participation is at the client’s own risk. The Center is not liable for personal

belongings, negligence, or undisclosed medical conditions.

9. Images and Marketing

Photos and videos may be taken for promotional use. Clients consent unless they object in writing prior to the activity.
