

Terms and Conditions

Dive Schedule:

We typically offer **two to three dives per day**, from Monday to Saturday. We meet at the dive center at 9:30 AM. After completing the necessary paperwork and getting ready, we drive to the dive site.

The first two dives are usually conducted back-to-back, with a short surface interval in between. After the second dive, we take a lunch break before heading out for the third dive.

If you choose to do only one or two dives, we can arrange to take you back to the dive center afterwards.

Our **schedule is flexible**, and we adapt each day based on our divers' needs and experience levels. Most of our dives take place in the El Toro Marine Reserve, where we have access to a wide range of dive sites suitable for all levels of experience.

Preparation:

- Please arrive wearing **swimwear** that you can wear under your wetsuit
- Please also bring a towel and **dry change** of clothes

Cancellation Policy:

- Deposits can be **cancelled free of charge up to 48 hours before the scheduled activity**.
- For cancellations made **within 48 hours**, a doctor's note of proof or trip cancellation will be required.
- If the activity needs to be **cancelled due to weather conditions**, the deposit will be fully refunded.

Discover Scuba Dive (DSD) for Children:

- We offer **Discover Scuba Dives for children from 10 years old**.
- However, diving **in late October can be challenging** for children due to colder water temperatures. They may need to wear double wetsuits and extra weights, which can make the experience more demanding than during the warmer months.
- Some children handle the conditions very well, but we like to mention this in advance to avoid any unpleasant surprises. Our priority is always that the child has a **great experience and enjoys diving**.

Discover Scuba Dive (DSD) - Overview:

- The Discover Scuba Dive experience lasts about **four hours**. We begin at the dive center with a **short introductory video**, after which we travel to the dive site and adjust the equipment.
- The experience includes:

- A **pre-dive briefing**
- Practice **of basic scuba skills** in confined water
- A guided **open-water dive**
- The dive lasts **30-45 minutes**, depending on air consumption.
- The maximum depth is **12 metres**, and we always adjust the depth to your comfort level
- The price is **€120 per person**.
- **Requirements:**
 - Minimum age: 10 years
 - Ability to swim 200 meters in open water without assistance

If you are **unable to swim**, the dive is still possible but will require additional staff supervision, increasing the price **to €160 per person**.

- Important: after diving, you must wait at least **12 hours before flying**

Snorkelling:

- The activity lasts **about three hours**, with around two hours in the water. We meet at the dive center and drive together to the snorkelling site
- The location offers a rocky beach with opportunities for **cliff jumping** and **relaxing in the sun**
- **Note:** life vests are not provided, so participants must be **able to swim**.

Open Water Diver (OWD) Course:

- The OWD course includes:
 - 5 theory modules
 - Four dives
 - A full equipment lesson
- The **theory and exams are completed via e-learning**, which you can do at your own pace. This typically takes **6 – 12 hours to complete**
- The **practical training** consists of four dive sessions, each lasting for about four hours, where you will practice exercises and complete your open water dives.
- You will also receive a 1-1.5 hours **equipment lesson**
- We keep the **schedule flexible**, so the course can fit around your holiday plans or work commitments
- The **minimum duration for the practical part is two days**. However, we recommend spreading the course over **three to four days** for an optimal and relaxed experience.

- We will **reserve your first dive**, and the remaining sessions will be scheduled based on your progress and availability
- **Requirements:**
 - Minimum age: 10 years
 - Ability to swim 200 meters without assistance in open water.
- **Course Booking:**

Advanced Open Water Diver (AOWD) Course:

- The Advanced Open Water Diver course costs includes five adventure dives, each with a corresponding e-learning theory module.
- The minimum course duration is 2 full days, though we recommend spreading it out over three to four days for a more relaxed experience.
- Available adventure dives include:
 - Deep Dive (mandatory)
 - Underwater Navigation (mandatory)
 - Peak Performance Buoyancy (strongly recommended)
 - Underwater Photography
 - Night Dive
 - Fish Identification
 - Underwater Naturalist
 - Search and Recovery
 - Nitrox (additional €20)
 - Boat Dive (additional €35)
 - Wreck Dive (additional €35)
- **Minimum group size for Night, Boat, and Wreck Dives:** 4 divers.
- **Insurance:** Diving insurance is mandatory in Spain. You can purchase this from us for €9/day, €20/week, or €50/year.

- **Note:** Course duration may be adjusted based on the student's comfort, ability to meet performance requirements, and weather conditions.
- **Prerequisites:**
 - Open Water Diver/Junior Open Water (or qualifying certification)
 - 15 years or older (12 years for Junior Advanced Open Water Diver)

Rescue Diver Course:

- To participate, you must have a valid **Emergency First Response (EFR)** certification within the last 24 months
- If you do not have this certification, you can complete the EFR course with us
- The course includes **two half-day practical sessions:** confined water training on day 1 and rescue scenarios on day 2
- If you require the EFR course, this will take approximately 3 hours.
- The theory portion is completed via **e-learning**
- **Prerequisites:**
 - Adventure Diver/Junior Adventure Diver (or qualifying certification) with completed Underwater Navigation Dive
 - EFR Primary and Secondary Care training (or qualifying training) within 24 months
 - 12 years or older
